The devastating fire of a year ago severely damaged several buildings in Cathedral Yard and destroyed the Royal Clarence Hotel, but in the aftermath, previously hidden architectural and decorative features from past centuries have been brought to light.

The Journals of John Marsh (1752-1828); Diarist, Composer and Writer – His Visits to Exeter, Sidmouth and Dawlish.
